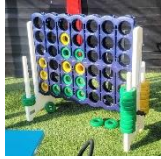


CAMBRIDGE COMMUNITY LIBRARY – APRIL 1, 2022

We are pleased to announce Cambridge Community Library received recognition as a new three-star library for 2021. The 2021 Index derives from data recently released by the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). For 2021, 5,608 U.S. public libraries qualified to be rated in the Index. In this edition, there are 262 Star Libraries, each receiving three-Star, four-Star, or five-Star designations.
