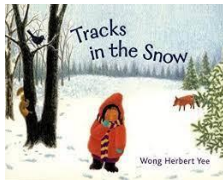

Winter Storywalk™ - January 12th – February 12th – Tracks in the Snow



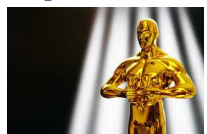
