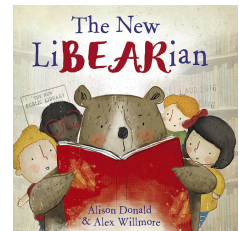
**Friday Flicks - July 21st @ 1:00pm: The Man from Toronto**
