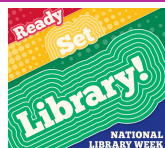

## National Library Week

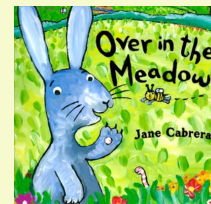
April 7 - 13; Library Celebration: Friday, April 12 at 3:00PM
